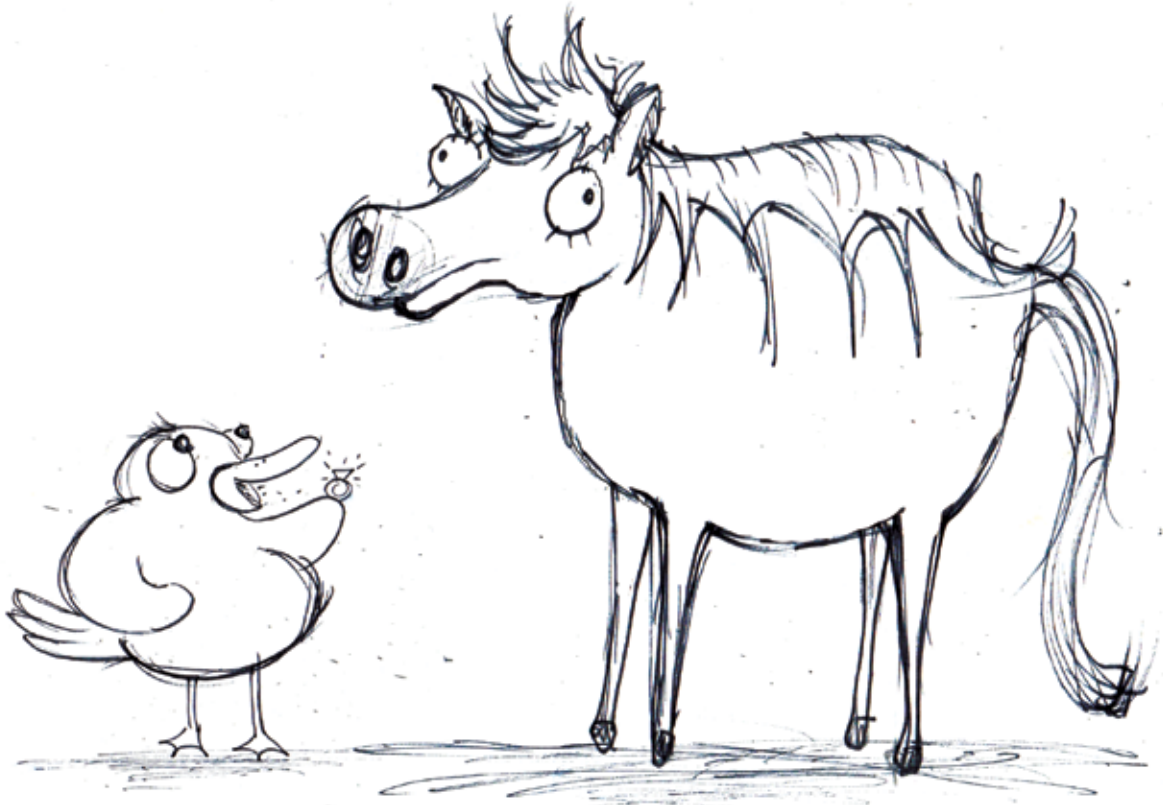

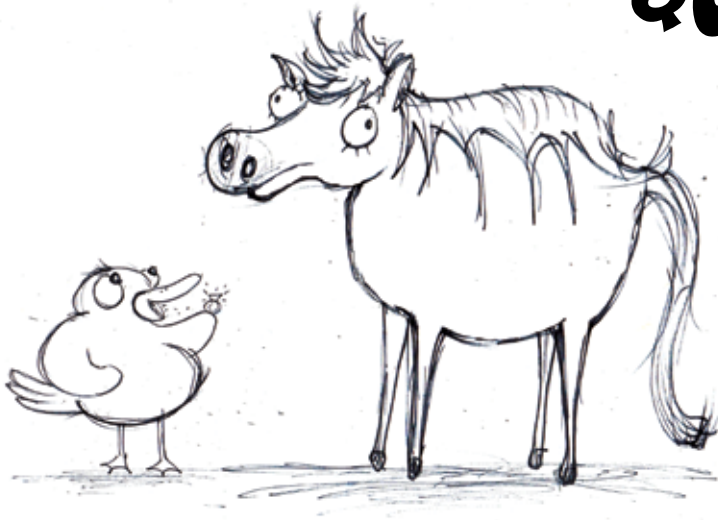

She greedily gobbled it in less than an hour.

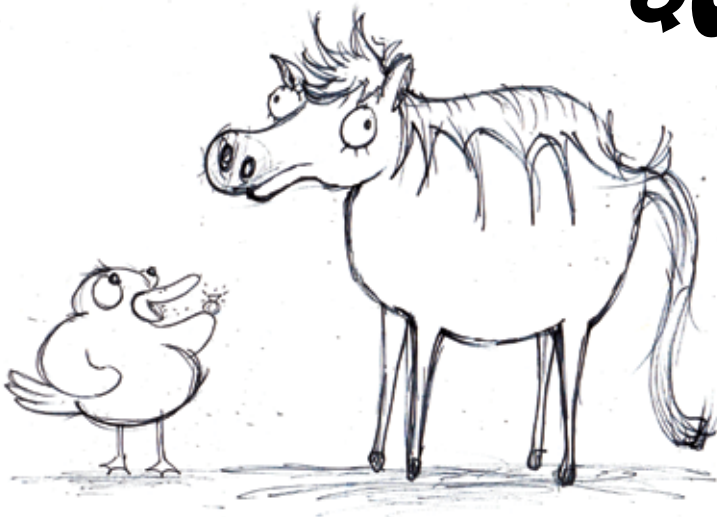
Duck said,

QUACK!



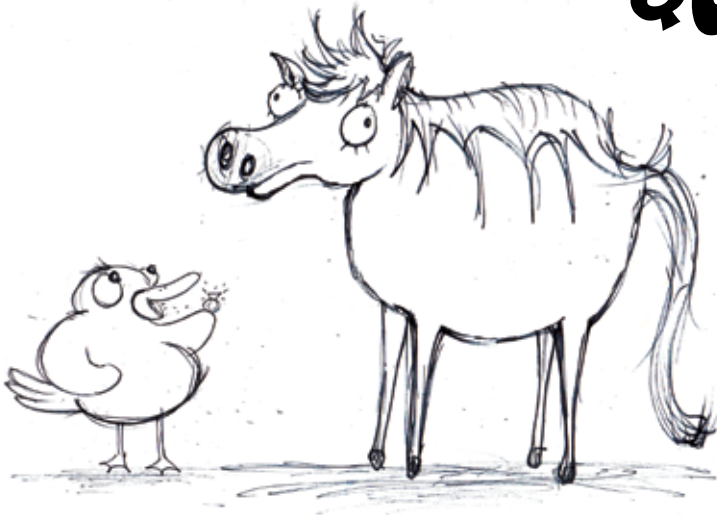
But she couldn’t speak Duck

QUACK!



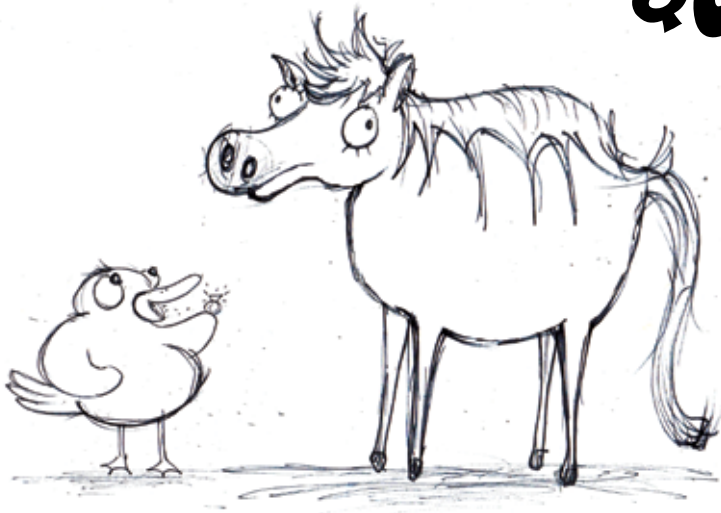
But she couldn’t speak Duck

so she couldn’t speak back.

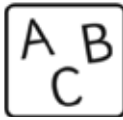
One day a handsome Stallion appeared,

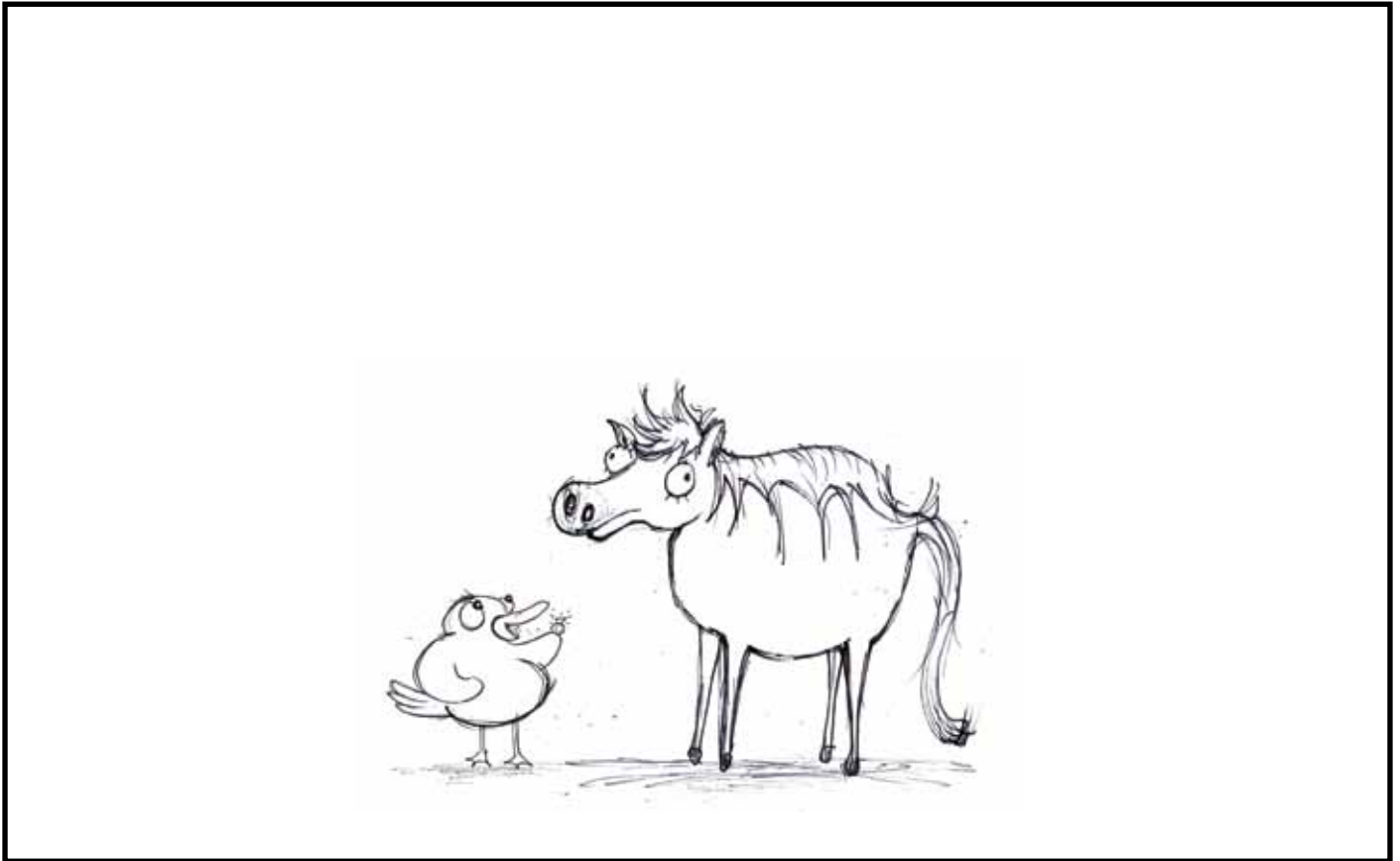
