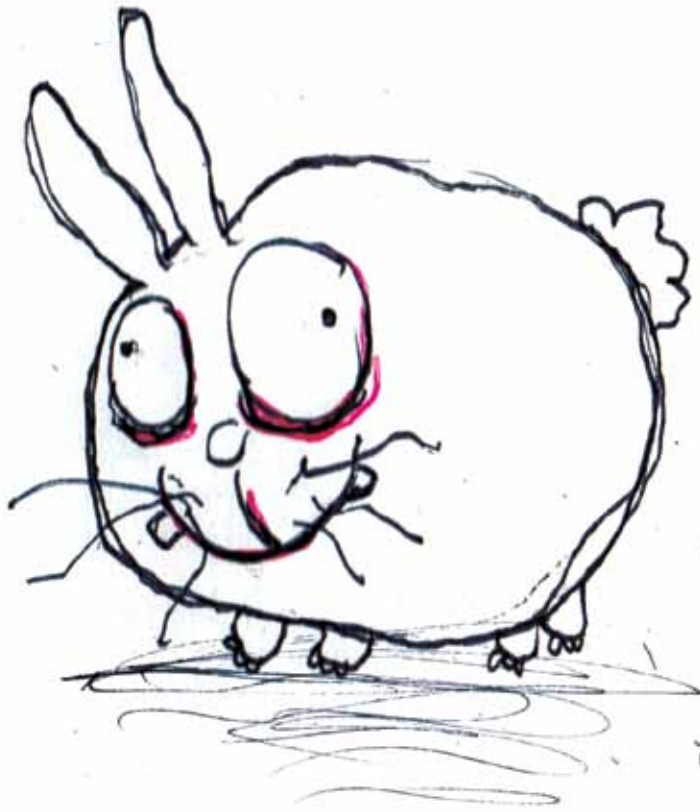

Betty said,

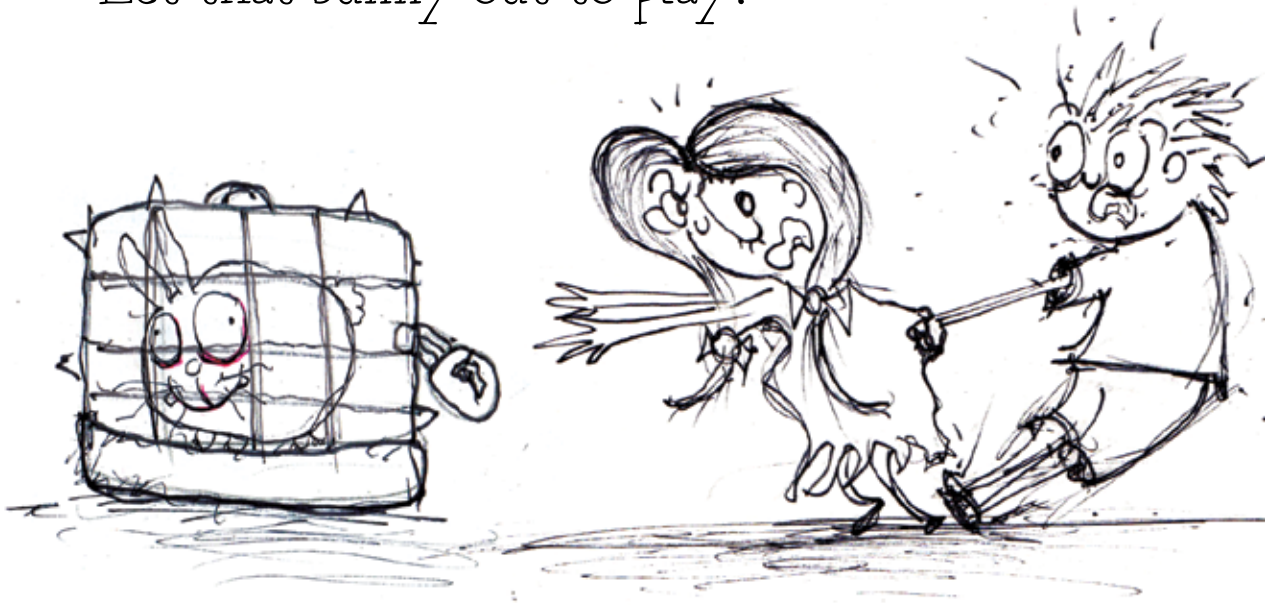

If you ever meet a rabbit that is small and puffy,

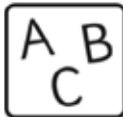
A rabbit that seems **TOO** cute and fluffy;

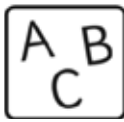

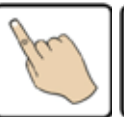
