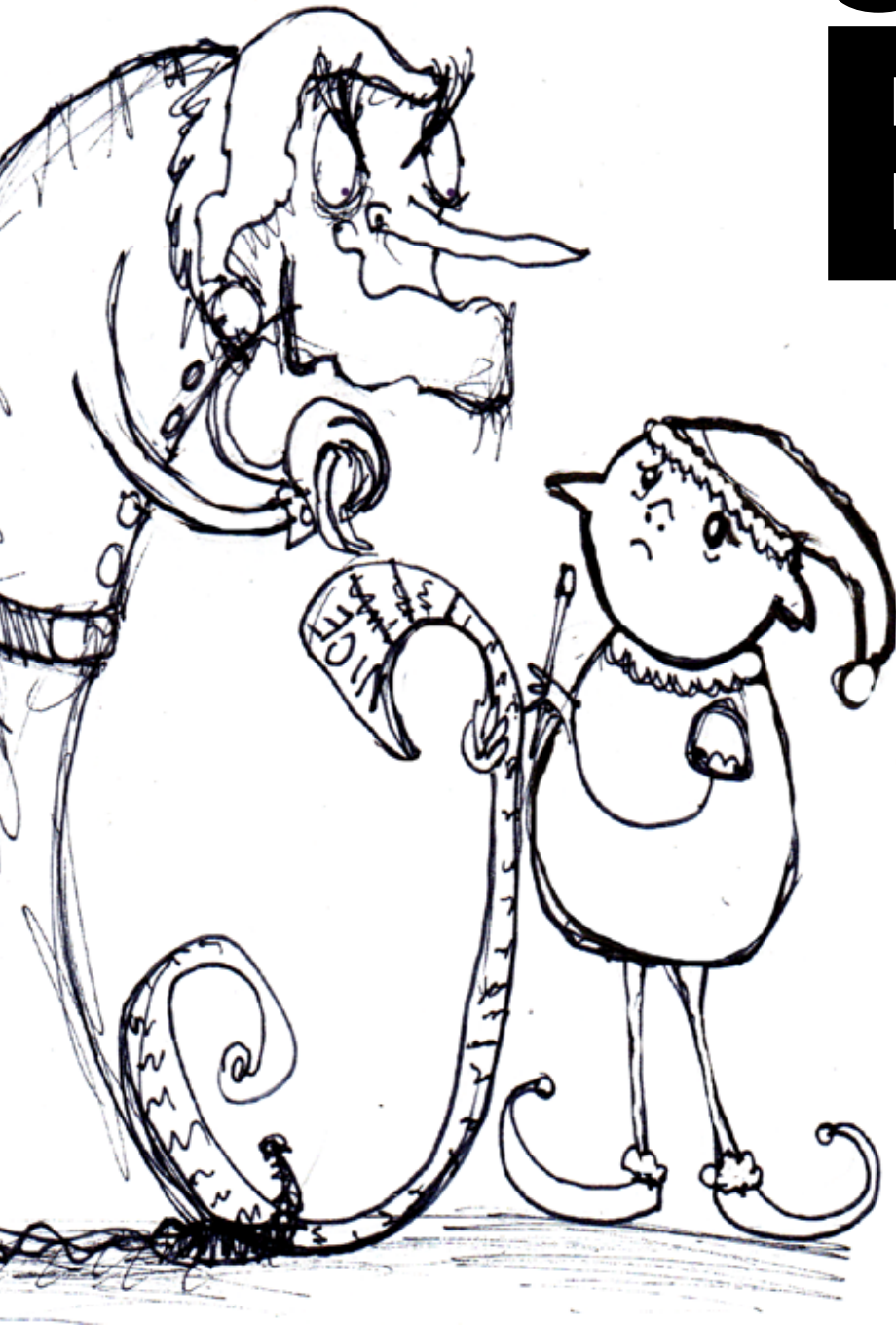

She smiles at everyone everywhere she goes!”

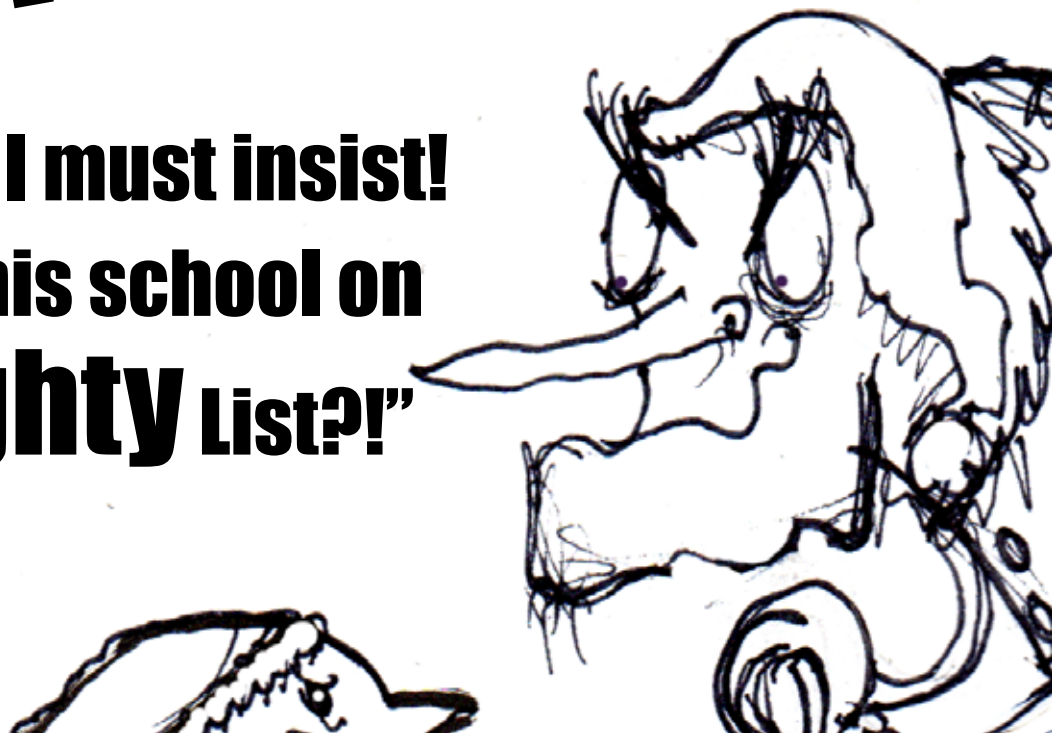
**“Ms Primrose may smile everywhere she goes,

YOU'RE ALL GOING ON MY NAUGHTY LIST!**

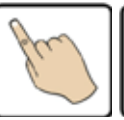
HA HA HA HA HA HA!”

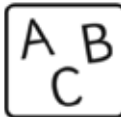

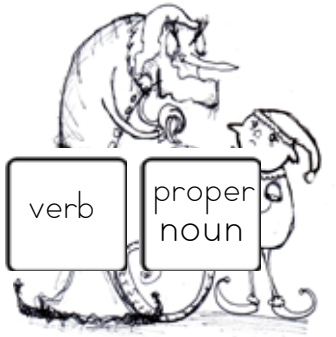
